Intercultural Learning Outcomes

- ✦ Understand the role of intercultural communication in everyday interactions in a foreign context
- ✦ Utilize a conceptual vocabulary for explaining and understanding intercultural communication; practice applying these concepts to on-site encounters
- ✦ Learn/assess how factors such as gender, history, socio-economic and cultural background, and politics and religion affect the way people see their world(s)
- ✦ Practice intercultural empathy and navigate one's way through (potential) intercultural conflicts/crises
- ✦ Practice reflexive thinking and interpret intercultural experiences from perspectives other than one's own
- ✦ Appreciate *difference* as resource

International Learning Outcomes

- ✦ Gain basic knowledge of Islam and of the major issues involving Muslim minorities/communities in Europe
- ✦ Understand the history and analyze the future of Muslim Presence in Europe
- ✦ Critically evaluate information sources on Islam/Muslims from the news media, political discourse, and academy
- ✦ Understand long-term interaction between the Muslim world and the West
